Listed below is the Mt. Lebanon employment history of 1 administrator, 5 professional staff and 9 support staff employees.

Administrator

- Mary Kay Davis started her career with the District as an elementary principal at Washington Elementary School. She was approved by the school board on September 20, 2010. She started her position on November 15, 2010. She previously held an elementary assistant principal position at McGuffey School District. She was known for her leadership in elementary science curriculum and guidance. She played a vital role in the development, implementation and growth of the ABA Special Education program that is housed at Washington Elementary. (6.5 years with Mt. Lebanon)

Professional Certificated Staff

- Barbara Austin, was hired as a school nurse in October, 2001. She worked among Markham Elementary, Jefferson Elementary and Jefferson Middle Schools throughout her years in the District. (16 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Linda Beebe began her teaching career as a permanent substitute teacher at Hoover Elementary School in January, 1979 and worked in various positions and schools as a permanent substitute through June, 1985. Linda returned to the District in November, 1993 as a permanent substitute, again at Hoover, and continued in substitute positions until she received a contract to teach first grade at Howe Elementary School beginning the 1997-1998 school year. (24 continuous years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Carol Cercone started her employment as a library clerk in 1992. During the 1996-97 school year, she worked as a substitute school librarian at Howe Elementary School. In August, 1998, Carol was given a contract as a school librarian at Howe, where she remained throughout her career. (25 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Laura Latus began as a substitute teacher in the District in February, 1985. She was hired for the 1994-1995 school year as a half-time contract and half-time permanent substitute physical education teacher in Mt. Lebanon Jr. High School. The following school year, she was awarded a full-time contract in the junior high school and moved to Jefferson Middle School in August, 1998, where she taught throughout the remainder of her career. (23 continuous years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Barbara Mandel started teaching as a substitute teacher in August, 1984. She subbed in other districts and was hired as a permanent substitute fifth grade teacher at Lincoln Elementary School in January, 1996. She stayed at Lincoln for two more years as a permanent substitute in grades 3 and 6. Beginning the 1998-1999 school year, Barbara accepted a contract teaching position in 6th grade at Mellon Middle School where she stayed for the rest of her years in the District. (21.5 continuous years with Mt. Lebanon)

- Timothy Cadman was hired as a substitute custodian in February, 2001. In April, 2001, Tim accepted a position as a contract custodian in the high school. He was reassigned to Washington Elementary School in November, 2001 where he remained for the remainder of his employment in the District. (16 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Sandra Callahan began working in August, 1993 as a parent assistant at Hoover Elementary School. In March, 1995, she was hired as an instructional clerk at Hoover. Sandra was given additional duties in February, 1998 in the Literature Strand. She moved to the high school in January, 2001 and worked as the word processing/instructional supervisors' clerk. As of August, 2010, Sandra was reassigned to the K-12 science laboratory assistant remaining in the high school through her retirement. (24 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Lisa Carper started her employment as a day-to-day substitute teacher in October, 1997. She accepted an assignment as a teacher assistant at Mellon Middle School in September, 1998. The following school year, she was reassigned to Jefferson Middle School. Beginning the 2001-2002 school year her assignment changed to a personal care assistant at Mellon Middle School where she stayed until she accepted a position as a special education classroom aide at the high school in September, 2013. Lisa continued in this position through her retirement in December, 2016. (20 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Valentina DeSilva was hired in October, 2007 as a clerical substitute. In July, 2008, she accepted the position of secretary to the assistant principal of Jefferson Middle School and retired from that same position in October, 2016. (9 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Susan Dunn was the study center coordinator in Mt. Lebanon High School from August, 1999 through her retirement at the end of the 2016-2017 school year. (18 years with Mt. Lebanon)
- Wayne Landy began working as a substitute custodian in January, 1996 and was offered a custodian position at Jefferson Middle School in August, 1998. In March, 1999, Wayne was reassigned to Markham Elementary school and finished his career there. (21 years with Mt. Lebanon)
