#### A. Financial Items

- 1. <u>Treasurer's Report</u> The treasurer's report reflects cash transactions for the month of December, 2022. The report is typical for this time of year, and the Superintendent recommends it for approval.
- 2. Monthly List of Bills The monthly list of bills reflects checks authorized to be drawn between December 8, 2022, to December 22, 2022. All checks have been reviewed by the administration and are typical of this time of year. The Superintendent recommends approval of this list.
- 3. <u>List of Unusable Equipment</u> The list of unusable equipment includes a 2010 Ford box truck in poor condition and seven commercial food warmers in poor condition. The Superintendent recommends approval of this list.
- 4. <u>School Supplies and Equipment Solicitations</u> Annually, the Board must approve the District's solicitation for bids on school supplies and equipment for the upcoming school year. Bids will be presented for Board approval at the May Board meeting pending approval of the Budget and verification that bids are within budgeted sums. The Superintendent recommends approval of this action.

#### B. Personnel Items

1. <u>Personnel Report</u> - The Personnel Report details personnel appointments, changes in assignments, leaves of absences, resignations, sabbaticals, and retirements to be considered by the Board.

#### C. Other

1. <u>Independent Food Services Consultant Agreement</u> - The District is seeking to extend an agreement for professional services to assist in the preparation and response to the audit requests, as we are completing the bi-annual review of our food service operations from the State Department of Food and Nutrition. The cost of this service will be \$300 per day

as needed, not to exceed 2 days per week. This will be paid from the Food Service Fund. The Superintendent recommends approval of this agreement.
