- Install and Arrange Physical Requirements for in person learning
- Board endorses move to Hybrid/Cyber Learning Phase (September 14)
- Families Declare - Hybrid/Cyber Learning Academy (September 17)
- Staffing - Working cooperatively with our unions
- Board considers motion to transition to Hybrid/Cyber (September 21)
- Phased reopening plan
- Monitor COVID Incidence Rate and Percent Positivity Rates and other local factors
