- \*(1) Monthly Personnel Report: RESOLVED, That the Board approves the March 10, 2022 list of personnel changes, as revised March 17, 2022.
- (2) <u>School Operation Services Inc. Agreement</u> RESOLVED, That the Board approves a 2-year agreement with School Operation Services to provide daily and long-term substitutes covering paraprofessionals, food services, classroom aides, and facilities positions.

#### C. Other

- (1) <u>2022-2023 AIU Program of Services Budget</u> RESOLVED, That the Board approves the AIU Program of Services Budget for 2022-2023 in the amount of \$2,243,179 with an estimated cost to the District of \$79,940.
- (2) Extended Day Summer Lease RESOLVED, That the Board approves the lease agreement with Mt. Lebanon Extended Day for the Summer 2022 program, at the cost of \$1,800 per week.
- (3) Educational Services Provided by The University School RESOLVED, That the Board approves a contract with The University School for the provision of special education services for Mt. Lebanon students with disabilities during the 2021-2022 school year. Services will begin February 28, 2022, and end June 6, 2022. The cost will not exceed \$8,666.66 per student, anticipated for no more than three (3) students.

- a. <u>High School Winter Guard</u> RESOLVED, That the Board approves the Mt. Lebanon High School Winter Guard trip to Wildwood, New Jersey on April 28 May 1, 2022.
- High School Orchestra RESOLVED, That the Board approves the Mt. Lebanon High School Orchestra trip to the Poconos, Pennsylvania, on April 7 - 9, 2022.
- (5) <u>Elevator Maintenance and Service</u> RESOLVED, That the Board approves the bid for elevator maintenance from Kone Elevator with a low bid of \$21,840 for year one, \$22,392 for year two, and \$23,448 for year three.
- (6) <u>Dust Control Services</u> RESOLVED, That the Board approves the proposal for dust control services from Cintas, Inc., who is our current provider. Cintas provided a one-year proposal of \$53,066.78 with a two-year extension option.
- \*(7) School Bus Replacement RESOLVED, That the Board approves the low bid from Meyers Equipment Corporation to supply a full-sized Thomas Built FreightLiner bus in the amount of \$111,891.00 less \$1,500.00 trade-in value for our existing bus for a total bid price of \$110,391.00. Additionally, the Facilities Department was able to obtain a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection as part of their Onroad Rebate Program in the amount of \$27,000.00, thereby bringing the net total to \$83,391.00. As part of the 2022-2023 Capital Projects list the Board previously approved \$105,000.00 for the purchase of this bus. The District will subsequently apply the grant funding when received.
