Gold Card Program

The Mt. Lebanon School District offers Gold Card membership to residents of the Mt. Lebanon Municipality who are 62 years of age or older. Membership in the Gold Card program offers the following benefits:

- ✓ Free general admission to any Mt. Lebanon School District sponsored home athletic event
 - NOTE - WPIAL playoff events hosted after the regular season are not sponsored by the Mt. Lebanon School District and would not qualify for Gold Card free admission
- ✓ Free general admission to one performance of each of the Mt. Lebanon School District sponsored dramatic or musical productions
- ✓ Discounted tuition on Adult Education Courses offered by Mt. Lebanon School District

Membership is free and proof of residency and proof of age are required at the time of application. Acceptable proof of age/residency includes: valid PA driver's license or identification card with a Mt. Lebanon address, lease or utility bill accompanied by proof of age.

Application must be made in-person, by the applicant. Gold Cards will not be issued by mail or to a representative of an eligible resident.
