

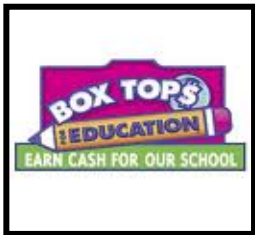

And don't forget to keep on usin'!



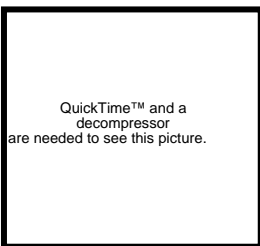
SHOP 'N SAVE S.E.E.D. PROGRAM

This is another easy program with which to assist our school! SHOP 'n SAVE sponsors The Students Extra Educational Development (S.E.E.D.) program. It is a free in-school assembly program bringing assemblies from Carnegie Science Center, Carnegie Museum of Natural History, and Pittsburgh Zoo & PPG Aquarium. Now instead of collecting receipts, you can link

your Perks Card with Washington to help bring an assembly to our school. After you link your Perks Card, just swipe it anytime you shop at SHOP 'n. SAVE and your purchases will automatically be added to the school's total. A total of \$250 spent is required for each student attending the assembly. However, gathering approximately \$100,000 in purchases is no easy task, so please start collecting now!
