## PTA Consolidated Fee Form, 2011-2012

(Updated August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2011)

Dear Washington Elementary School (WES) Parents/Guardians:

Welcome! This PTA Consolidated Fee Form is designed to make your life a little easier. At the beginning of the school year, you generally are flooded with PTA flyers providing information about our upcoming special events and our PTA membership. Some of these activities request a minimal one-time payment or donation. In order to combine all of this information into one place, the PTA Consolidated Fee Form (attached) has been created for your use.

**We ask that EACH FAMILY COMPLETE THIS FORM and return it by SEPTEMBER 9<sup>th</sup>—even if you do not plan on participating in some of the activities—because we need your contact information for distribution of Washington newsletter (Section D). Below is a summary of each category:**

**A) HOUSEHOLD DATA:** This information is needed for two reasons:

1. To gather the adult/guardian data so that if one or both adults join the PTA, this data will be included in the Washington Elementary School Directory (Section B below, PTA Membership).
2. To ensure that the guardian(s) of each student is/are receiving the Washington newsletter electronically or in hardcopy (Section D below, Washington Newsletter).

Please PRINT legibly and list the information as you wish to have it shown in the PTA Directory.

**B) PTA MEMBERSHIP:** *The PTA is having a contest! The students of the classroom with the highest percentage of possible adults joining the PTA will receive a special treat! Deadline for signing up for membership—Friday, September 9<sup>th</sup>.* A few of the reasons we encourage ALL ADULTS/GUARDIANS to join the PTA:

1. Your \$8 membership fee will go toward programs that benefit your child throughout the year—for example, the Fall Family Picnic, lunchtime clubs, and field trips, to name just a few.
2. You'll receive a Washington School Directory in October that will list all PTA members and other pertinent information, such as a listing of the WES staff and descriptions of the PTA committees.
3. By being a PTA member, you are eligible to serve as a PTA Board officer.

**C) HOMEROOM PARTY MONEY:** The PTA provides three (3) parties—Halloween, Holiday, and Valentine—each school year for the students. Adults facilitate these events by planning and participating in the parties during the school day. However, some guardians do not have the opportunity to volunteer in this way but wish to assist through the donation of money so that paper and other party supplies can be purchased. This is a perfect way to lend a hand!

For this reason, adults are encouraged to **contribute \$5.00 per student** to help defray the costs of all 3 parties, and the party planners for your child's classroom will use this money to purchase the items needed for the party. The money collected for this fund is equally distributed between all classrooms based on the number of students in the class.

- At the end of the school year any remaining funds not used for reimbursement, will be donated back to an area of the school, such as the Library, that will benefit all WES students.

**D) WASHINGTON NEWSLETTER:** The PTA keeps our families informed about what goes on at our school through our newsletter called the *Washington Weekly News*. This newsletter is filled with wonderful information such as important upcoming school dates, PTA news or events, community bulletins, and other updates.

Please specify the e-mail address(es) that you would like to receive the Washington Weekly News and other important school communications. **These e-mail addresses are not shared with anyone outside of our school community.**

However, some of our families do not have access to a computer. If this is the case for your family, we ask that you check the box in this section. **Additionally, in order to start receiving the electronic newsletter as soon as school starts, you may choose to directly contact our Corresponding Secretary, Rosie Pesacreta (rs.pesacreta@verizon.net), with your e-mail address immediately.**

**E) FALL FAMILY PICNIC—Tuesday, 9/20/11, 5:30-7:30 pm:** This special event kicks off the school year for Washington students and their families, as well as teachers and staff, with camaraderie, food, games, and other fun events! Everyone is invited, and you are welcome to have dinner at the picnic—which you can purchase through this form—or you can plan to eat beforehand.

If you want to have dinner at the picnic, complete Section E by ordering the number and type of pizza(s) that your family would like and/or the number of hot dogs that you wish to purchase. Your dinner will be ready for you when you come to the picnic, and drinks can be bought separately at the event.

**F) GIANT EAGLE—APPLES FOR STUDENTS PROGRAM:** By registering your Giant Eagle Advantage Card through the Apples for Students program, points will be granted to our school every time you shop at Giant Eagle. This is a GREAT program—an extra easy way you can help earn much needed equipment and supplies for our school.

We thought we'd make it easy for you—in Section F, you can insert your 12-digit Giant Eagle Advantage Card number, and we'll call Giant Eagle and register your number and link it to our School ID. (Your number begins with a 4 and is found at the bottom of the bar code on the back of your card.) Then, just shop at Giant Eagle as you normally do! If you have registered, consider inserting a grandparent or other relative's number if they aren't already part of the Apples for Students program.

The program runs and points are allotted from September through March. *Please note—participating in this program does not affect your fuelperks.*

**GRAND TOTAL:** This section adds up the totals of the portions of the form that include fees so that you can write a single check to the Washington PTA. In advance, we appreciate your support and look forward to your participation in upcoming PTA activities. **Please remember to return this form (and your check) to the designated PTA box in the front office by September 9<sup>th</sup>.**

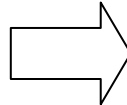
